

2021-2022 fiscal year saw the completion of 18 critical home repairs in our service area, bringing the total number of homes impacted since 2007 as 213 and 11 Rehabs.







We ended this fiscal year with a new site for future homes in the Borough of Steelton. We are planning to build four homes over the next two fiscal years.









A WORD FROM OUR EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

In the fiscal year ending on June 30, 2021, Habitat for Humanity of the Greater Harrisburg Area was overcoming the challenges stemming from the pandemic. We waited through work stoppages on home repair sites and ReStore, due to possible and actual COVID-19 infections. We waited for building materials on backorder to be delivered. We waited to get appointments with subcontractors, who were already over capacity, to visit our new sites for project estimates for permitting. As I am sure you are aware, homes and land have been unaffordable for homebuyers for years, but in the last two years rising scarcity has pushed prices out of reach for even some developers. Thanks to your gifts, volunteering, and prayers, we have been blessed with opportunities to help local families overcome the obstacles failing them in the housing market. We have more seeds to sow. You are the means of rising to the challenge. We are building back and excited about it. In 2021 we began working towards building two new homes in Dauphin County with the expected completion date for 2022, we completed 13 home repairs in only 6 months due to COVID-19 challenges and were able to work with 1,124 volunteers for a total number of 7,391 volunteer hours. Thanks to the generosity of the community, our ReStore received over 2,000 donations that directly impact affordable housing. Well done! Thank you! We are excited about the changes occurring at Harrisburg Habitat and look forward to 2022 and beyond.



Through our supportive relationship and partnerships with the Borough of Steelton, the NRMCA, and the ICFMA, Habitat for Humanity of the Greater Harrisburg Area will be able to make an impact on the community and provide affordable housing for those families in need of the strong foundation of homeownership.
